

SHEDDING LIGHT ON MOSES' SEVEN OBJECTIONS

Moses was a great man of God, but he had some failings. As you follow his account in Exodus it is clear that he had a temper problem that cost him much... **Numbers 20:1-13; Exodus 32:19-20.**

At times – just like us – he was also hesitant to be involved in the Lord's service and he came up with objections. Let's study seven of them and see how much like Moses we are.

1. Who am I? - **Exodus 3:11**
2. What shall I say? - **Exodus 3:13**
3. Who will believe me? - **Exodus 4:1**
4. I am not eloquent! - **Exodus 4:10**
5. Send someone else - **Exodus 4:13**
6. Israel will not listen - **Exodus 6:12**
7. I speak with faltering lips - **Exodus 6:30**

Like Moses, we need to drop the objections that hinder us in our service and trust God with any outcome of the labours He calls us to.
